

Free Training for Year 12 Graduates

What is free training for Year 12 graduates?

Free training means eligible Year 12 graduates are exempt from paying student contribution fees under the Certificate 3 Guarantee and User Choice programs.

Under this initiative the Queensland Government will cover the full cost of training for eligible qualifications. This means eligible students will not be required to contribute to their training fees.

Who can access the fee-free training?

To be eligible to access fee-free training you must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ you must have completed Year 12 in Queensland
- ✓ you must hold a Senior Statement issued by the Queensland Studies Authority or the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority or equivalent
- ✓ you must enrol in your chosen course by the end of the calendar year following your completion of year 12
- ✓ you must live permanently in Queensland.

What courses can I study fee-free at C&K College of Early Childhood?

The following courses are supported by the Queensland Government under 'free training for Year 12 graduates' funding:

CHC30113 - Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

This course is available fee-free under *Certificate 3 Guarantee* or *Traineeship* funding.

CHC50113 - Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care

This course is available fee-free under *Apprenticeship* funding.
