## **About us...**

*Camp Hill Kindergarten* is a community based non-profit organisation run by parents for their children.

It is affiliated with C&K. This means that everything including staff, educational programs and equipment are of an approved standard.

The centre is operated by a management committee which is elected from the current parent body. The committee is responsible for employing staff, payment of wages, collecting fees, purchasing and maintaining equipment, buildings and grounds.

*Adult/Child Ratio* is a maximum of 22 children in each kindy group with a qualified early childhood teacher and teaching assistant.

*Staff Qualifications...* Our staff are qualified early childhood teachers who have training in interacting with, observing and planning educational programs for children aged 0 - 8 years.

## ***The Classes***

Our Centre offers two 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  year old kindy programs. To be eligible, children must turn 4 by 30 June in the year they will attend.

A 5 day per fortnight program on either Monday and Tuesday (and alternate Wednesdays) or Thursday and Friday (and alternate Wednesdays). Program hours 8.30am to 2.35pm

Also an extended 2 day program on Monday & Tuesday or Thursday & Friday. Program hours are 7.50am to 3.30pm.

We also offer a one day pre kindy program for children that have turned 3 by 31 December in the year prior to their attending. Hours are Wednesday 9 am to 2.30pm.

We only operate during school terms.

## ***Waiting List***

A child's name can be placed on the waiting list from birth.

## ***Educational Program***

The overall objective at Camp Hill Kindergarten and Preschool is to encourage children to actively learn, question, think and find out - about their world with enthusiasm and confidence.

Through daily observations, the staff are able to plan developmentally appropriate learning experiences which respond to individual needs, interests and abilities of each child.

The *curriculum* incorporates a wide variety of learning experiences which

- Promote social, emotional and physical growth
- Foster active exploration, problem solving and discovery
- Encourage children to make choices and decisions, and to accept responsibility
- Promote acceptance of self and others

## ***Parent Involvement***

Our Centre acknowledges the close relationship which exists between young children and their families. We strive to foster close links with home through...

- Establishing a warm, friendly atmosphere where children and their families feel welcome
- Day to day contact - parents are encouraged to spend a special day each term at the centre and to contribute to our program with any special skills or interests

## ***Fees***

Fees are set by the Committee each year.

The centre receives a government subsidy which allows fees to be kept to a minimum.
