SESSION TIMES

We offer Pre-prep education for children aged 3 & 1/2 to 5 years. Our class sizes are small, with only 18 children per group.

We cater for two Pre-Prep Groups:

GROUP 1: RED ROOS (3 short days)

Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday

8.30am - 1.30pm

GROUP 2: BLUE EMUS (2 long days)

Tuesday/Thursday

8.30am - 4.00pm

We follow the same terms as the state school education system, except we do not have pupil free days.

Kindergarten Funding Scheme

Our centre is eligible to receive the KFS funding from the Office of Early Childhood Education and Care (OECEC). From 2011 this will replace DEKAS (Department of Education Kindergarten Assistance Scheme).

Under the new KFS (Kindergarten Funding Scheme), we will receive the standard \$2,100 per child, plus an extra remote ARIA subsidy of \$1,050 per year, for each child enrolled in the eligible age cohort.

Children must be four years of age before 30 June in the year they attend Kindergarten

C&K Charleville Kindergarten Fees

The KFS is a subsidy which helps our management committee keep fees as low as possible. However, to remain operational and offer a quality program, we are required to charge a standard fee.

In 2011 our fees will be \$61.50 per week.

You will be invoiced on a per term basis. We operate under the same terms as State Schools.

In 2011 all Kindy fees will be \$615 per term

Payment options are available.
