

COVID update 15 July 2021

Dear Families,

As you may be aware, the Queensland Government has announced [restrictions will be extended](#) to Friday 23 July 2021 in the following local government areas:

- Brisbane
- Logan
- Moreton Bay
- Ipswich
- Redlands
- Sunshine Coast
- Gold Coast
- Noosa
- Somerset
- Lockyer Valley
- Scenic Rim

Considering this, **C&K centres located in the above local government areas** will continue to implement **Response Level Yellow (Medium Response)** as outlined in C&K's [COVID-19 Commitment Statement](#). This means:

- Staff who live and work in the above local government areas will be required to wear a mask when travelling to and from work on public transport and when interacting with adults, but not when working with children in the learning spaces, including the outdoors.
- Families who live, work or study in the above local government areas are requested to wear a mask whilst at a C&K centre unless a person has a [lawful reason not to](#). Children under 12 years of age are not required to wear a mask.

Centres located outside the above local government areas will move to **Response Level Green (Low Response)** as outlined in C&K's [COVID-19 Commitment Statement](#). This means families, staff, and visitors no longer need to wear a mask while at a C&K centre. However, if you feel more comfortable wearing a mask, please feel free to do so. We want you to feel as safe as possible.
