

COVID update 29 June 2021

Dear Families,

I am writing to update you on advice relating to the emerging COVID situation across Queensland. The Queensland Government has announced a **3 day lockdown for Brisbane, Gold Coast, Ipswich, Lockyer Valley, Logan, Moreton Bay, Noosa, Redlands, Scenic Rim, Sunshine Coast, Somerset, Townsville City (including Magnetic Island), and Palm Island from 6pm today.**

**All C&K centres in these areas remain open and all enrolled children are able to attend over the lockdown period.**

We ask you to please keep your child home if they are unwell or showing any signs of illness. We assure you that the safety of your children, families and our staff is our first priority, and ask that you follow the Commitments in the [C&K COVID-19 Commitment Statement](#). We are currently operating at **Response Level Yellow**.

Please ensure that you adhere to physical distancing guidelines of 1.5 metres and hand washing guidelines when attending your centre. C&K centre staff will be following enhanced cleaning procedures.

All adults are required to wear a mask when at the centre unless they have a lawful reason not to.

C&K centre staff in the lockdown areas will be required to wear a mask when travelling to and from work on public transport and when interacting with adults, but not when working with children in the learning spaces, including the outdoors.
