

COVID update 30 March 2021

Dear Families,

I would like to update you further on the situation for C&K Kindergartens and Childcare centres in the regions of **Brisbane, Logan, Moreton Bay, Ipswich and Redlands**. C&K centres will remain open over the coming days for children of essential workers and children who are experiencing vulnerability or disadvantage.

What is an essential worker?

The Department of Education has confirmed that an essential worker is anyone not able to work from home or if they are working at home and are unable to adequately supervise their child and complete work. We are aware of the challenges of trying to work at home when caring for young children. Children of these workers can attend kindergarten or Childcare.

Children whose families may be experiencing vulnerability or disadvantage can also attend. If you feel that it is best for your child to attend kindergarten or Childcare, then we encourage your child to attend.

Will centre events be going ahead?

According to the Queensland Health guidelines, all centre events will be postponed for the time being.
