

**COVID-19 update – arrival and departure routines - 08/02/2021**

*Dear Families,*

*I hope the first few weeks are going well and your child is settling into new routines and developing confidence for an exciting year ahead.*

*With borders re-opening and the current low risk of COVID-19 in Queensland, we have also eased the arrival and departure requirements under the current C&K [COVID-19 Commitment Statement](#).*

*Effective Monday, 8 February 2021, there will no longer be:*

- *Time limits for families to drop off and collect their children.*
- *Restrictions on the number of people that can drop off and collect children.*

*The current requirements around physical distancing of 1.5 metres during arrival and departure routines will still apply.*

*We are currently reviewing and creating an updated version of the C&K COVID-19 Commitment Statement that will support children, families and staff through any changes to future COVID-19 restrictions. This will allow C&K to be agile and respond appropriately as situations arise.*
