

Childcare attendance form April-June 9/04/2020

Dear Families,

Recent [Australian Government changes to childcare](#) mean that your centre can now stay open at no charge to you. In line with the new Government guidelines, C&K will be prioritising care for essential workers and those children who are experiencing vulnerability or disadvantage.

Essential Workers are those who are currently needing to attend work. This includes those who are working from home. Children experiencing vulnerability may be those whose doctor or another professional has recommended that they attend an early learning centre.

What this means for your family

Your current enrolment (as at April 3rd, 2020) will continue, but we need more information from you about your plans for attendance. Please fill out this [Attendance Form](#) before Friday 17 April 2020 to ensure we can continue to provide your family with the care you need.

We understand that you may be able to keep your child at home, in which case, your place will be held. When you decide to return, we will require you to give us notice.

Extra days may be available, however your centre director will need to prioritise care for essential workers and those children who are experiencing vulnerability or disadvantage.

By doing this, you will be helping us to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our children, our families, and our staff. This will help us give priority of care to those in our community who need it the most during these challenging times.
