

## Coronavirus health advice update 01/03/2020

Dear Families,

The Australian Government Department of Health has now extended the existing travel restrictions around COVID-19 to include Iran and China.

### What does this mean?

Children or staff **cannot** attend school or early childcare centre if they have:

- left, or transited through mainland China in the last 14 days (they must isolate themselves for 14 days from leaving mainland China)
- left, or transited through Iran on or after 1 March (they must isolate themselves until 14 days after leaving Iran)
- been in close contact with a confirmed case of coronavirus in the last 14 days (they must isolate themselves for 14 days after the date of last contact with the confirmed case).

Your kindergarten or childcare centre director should be notified if your child is unable to attend.

The Australian Government will review all travel restrictions again on the 6<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
