

Coronavirus health advice update 15/03/2020

Dear Families,

You will no doubt have seen the Prime Minister's press conference today regarding COVID-19. At this stage kindergartens and childcare centres will remain open.

C&K will be closely monitoring the situation and in response to the increased advice we will be restricting all non-essential activities such as incursions, excursion and visitors to centres. We will also be talking to Universities and VET Colleges to postpone arrangements for new students who may be about to begin a professional experience at a C&K Centre.

You will have also seen the advice that **all people entering Australia from midnight tonight are to self-isolate for 14 days**. This is an expansion of previous advice and C&K staff have been advised today that this requirement needs to be strictly adhered to by both staff and families.

If your child is unwell or presenting with flu like symptoms, please keep them at home and seek medical advice.

We will keep you up to date with information as it becomes available to us.
