Communication to C&K families - 23 December 2021

Dear Families,

Many thanks for your continued support towards keeping the C&K community safe and healthy.

With the number of COVID-19 cases across Queensland rising, the C&K COVID-19 Taskforce has decided to increase our COVID-19 response level to 'YELLOW' under the [C&K COVID-19 Commitment Statement](#):



In addition to the 'Green' commitments currently in place, C&K teachers and educators will:

- Perform 2 hourly cleans (detergent and disinfectant) of frequently touched surfaces
- Review centre arrival and departure routines i.e. foyer/gate drop off and pick up of children

When attending your C&K centre, we kindly request you to:

- When possible, maintain physical distancing of 1.5m between C&K staff and other families
- Wash hands upon your arrival and departure
- Keep your child at home when unwell
- Regularly check the [Qld Health Contact Tracing Exposure Sites](#) and follow public health instructions
- Carry and wear a face mask when physical distancing is not possible (not mandatory)
