

Update from C&K - Kindergarten Support package 29/04/2020

Dear Families,

I am writing to provide you with an update about the Queensland Government Kindergarten Support package.

Since I last wrote to you to advise of the support package, C&K has completed our assessment of the guidelines and how they apply to our enrolled families.

There is no Government funding for non-eligible aged children (i.e. children who turn four on or after 1st July 2020) or children who attend for more than 30 hours per fortnight. C&K has however determined that, **all children, regardless of the age, can have access to no fee kindergarten for 30 hours per fortnight during Term 2.**

For children who attend more than one kindergarten group, the normal daily fee will be charged for the enrolment in the second kindergarten group. These charges will be reflected on your Customer Account Statement that will be sent to you shortly, providing more information on payment of these fees.

Children who are learning at home

The above applies to all enrolled children regardless of whether they are attending kindergarten or accessing learning at home.

C&K are committed to ensuring continuity of learning for all of our children and we trust that this fee help will support families during this time.

Thank you for your patience and understanding and I hope your child is enjoying term two.
