

Updated COVID-19 Commitment Statement Version 3.0 – Families 13/11/20

Dear Families,

Thank you for your continued support through the COVID-19 pandemic. By taking the necessary precautions and adhering to our COVID Safe guidelines, you have helped us protect the health and wellbeing of children, families, and our employees.

As the threat continues to remain low in Queensland, we have updated the [C&K COVID-19 Commitment Statement Version 3](#) to reflect the further easing of restrictions in Queensland.

What has changed?

Broadly, these changes cover the following:

Centre gatherings - Where possible, centres are encouraged to keep gatherings small. However, larger group gatherings are now possible under COVID Safe procedures and measures.

Excursions - With COVID Safe measures in place, centres are now able to plan excursions.

Drop off/pick-up routines - In consultation with families, each centre will determine an appropriate approach to drop off and pick up routines. As always, we welcome families into our centres to engage with children in their learning environment. As we move closer towards the end of the year, kindergarten children who have become more independent over the past few months may wish to continue with established routines, which are likely to be more like what children will experience at school.
