

## Updated advice regarding novel coronavirus 30/1/2020

Dear Families,

Further to our email this morning concerning novel coronavirus, I want to reassure you that the health and wellbeing of your child and family remains our main focus. We will continue to be guided by the Australian Government on how we can reduce any impact this ongoing health issue may have on you and your family.

I understand that there has been considerable media coverage of the issue and I want to provide clear information about what the latest Queensland Health guidelines might mean for you and your family. C&K now requires that:

- any child or adult (including our staff and families) who has travelled from China and/or Hong Kong in the past 14 days must self-isolate and should not attend or visit a childcare or kindergarten centre until 14 days after the date of their departure from China or Hong Kong.
- any child or adult who has had contact with a confirmed novel coronavirus case must self-isolate and not attend or visit a childcare or kindergarten centre for 14 days following their exposure.

Please be assured that we are communicating this requirement to all families and staff at C&K. I would also like to assure you that we are constantly monitoring any updates to the Australian Government guidelines and will keep you updated in the event this advice changes.
