

Updated health advice regarding novel coronavirus 29/01/2020

Dear families,

As you may be aware, Queensland Health (QH) advised last night that Queensland has its first confirmed case of novel coronavirus. C&K's first priority is the safety and wellbeing of the children and staff at our kindergarten and childcare centres and as such are providing all of our families with the updated Queensland Health advice.

The updated advice provided by Queensland Health applies to any child or adult (including staff and families) who has travelled to China and Hong Kong in the past 14 days and who will be attending a childcare or kindergarten centre.

- Contacts of any confirmed novel coronavirus case must self-isolate for 14 days following exposure.
- Returned travellers who have visited China or Hong Kong, should not attend school, childcare [kindergarten] or TAFE for 14 days after leaving China or Hong Kong. This includes students, teachers and anyone who works or attends these facilities.
- Self-isolation means staying at home and not accepting visitors.
